Id AYU0165) with 45 seats [instead of 50 seats] in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan- 02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa - 08 seats and <u>Denial of Permission</u> in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta- 02 seats, (ii) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Smt Kamladevi Gauridutt Mittal Punarvasu Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, N.S Road, Marine Drive, Behind Taraporewala Aquarium, Mumbai-400002 Maharashtra (Inst. Id AYU0165) inspection of your College was conducted on 15.05.2023 & 16.05.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 14 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan- 02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa- 08 seats (iii) Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta- 02 seats, (iv) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

- In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 48th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 20 .07.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 22.07.2023 to appear on 26.07.2023 and same was rescheduled on 04.08.2023 as per your request and an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 01.08.2023 was provided to you to appear before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your with 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 14 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan- 02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa- 08 seats (iii) Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta-02 seats, (iv) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24. The college was directed to make written submission and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide letter no. KGMP/NCISM/Hearing Reply/1562/2023 dated 02.08.2023 against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
- 4. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dr**, **Ajay tryambakrao Sawalonke**, **Principal** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **04.08.2023** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under: -

- 5. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2022 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 51st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 08.08.2023.
- 6. In view of the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and it was found that the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa 08 seats and not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission with 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course and in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta- 02 seats, (ii) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 due to following reason:
 - a. <u>For UG Course:</u> Availability of Total Teaching staff is 26 against the minimum requirement of 27 as per schedule- v Note (iii) of MSR 2016 and not fulfilling the criteria as per MSR 2016.
 - b. For PG Course- As per sub regulation 7 and 8 of regulation 6 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016, "The minimum additional teaching staff required for starting post-graduate course shall be one Professor or Reader and one Lecturer of the concerned subject, in addition to the teachers stipulated for under-graduate teaching and The post-graduate department or specialty shall have minimum one Professor in concerned subject or specialty from the academic session 2017-18.

However, in the department of Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta, college is having 03 eligible faculty (01 Assistant Professor for PG and 01 Assistant Professor for UG and 01 Sanskrit teacher) and in the department of Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana, college is having 02 eligible faculty (01 Associate Professor for UG Course, and 01 Assistant Professor for UG Course) and there is shortcoming of Professor in the department of Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta and Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana against the minimum requirement of 01 professor in concerned subject as per sub regulation 8 of regulation 6 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016.

7. However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24.

"For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity."

Accordingly as per Schedule–V Note (iii) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 51st Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 26 total eligible Teaching faculty excluding excess staff and additional staff for PG course.

There is deficiency of 01 teacher for issuance of conditional permission for academic session 2023-24 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. Therefore, in accordance of Reduction policy 2023-2024, for deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity. Therefore, after applying the seat Reduction Policy college in UG course college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 45 seats [instead of 50 seats] in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan- 02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa-08 seats and denial of permission in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta- 02 seats, (ii) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.

- 8. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and after applying the seat Reduction Policy, <u>Conditional Permission</u> is issued to Smt Kamladevi Gauridutt Mittal Punarvasu Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, N.S Road, Marine Drive, Mumbai-400002, Maharashtra (Inst. Id AYU0165) with 45 seats [instead of 50 seats] in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan- 02 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa 08 seats and <u>denial of permission</u> in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita Siddhanta- 02 seats, (ii) Ras Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 02 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.
 - (i) The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - (ii) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 45 seats [instead of 50 seats] and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 10 seats in 02 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

- 10. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 11. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - (i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
 - (iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- 13. The fulfillment of the shortcoming mentioned in the hearing committee minutes and aforementioned conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
